
Its projection is oriented both within the Educational System and outside it, reaching all those who accompany and care for families, through an essential training of the young people who will be future mothers and fathers.

- To insert Prenatal Pedagogy as an important part of the Objectives of the Agenda for Sustainable Development (UN), which could contribute significantly to making these objectives a reality.
- To propose the inclusion of Prenatal Pedagogy in the curricular plans of all disciplines that make up Prenatal Education.
- To include Prenatal Pedagogy in educational laws and the curricula of Childhood, Primary, Secondary and High School Education.
- To divulge this information adequately to adolescents and young adults to make them aware of the importance of generating a new life and the need to prepare for that occupation, which the majority of them will exercise in the future, with responsibility and knowledge.
